Sarah, how did you enjoy playing Pamela?

In answer to your question, I can tell you that I thoroughly enjoyed playing Pamela although I felt that they [the producers] lost their direction with me, a little by the second season. They just didn't know what to do with Pamela Lynch after it was established that the viewing audience didn't like the plot line with the cartel!

Are you still in contact with your fellow cast members? Who were your favorite cast members to work with?

I am still in contact with Bob Foxworth and have enjoyed his friendship and advice over the years. Susan Sullivan was also somebody that I became very fond of though I have lost track of her at the moment. Lorenzo was also another big favourite of mine!

How did you like filming on location in the Napa Valley?

I was so very lucky to film in the Napa Valley. It is possibly one of the loveliest locations that I have been on in America.

I didn't watch the show after I left. I had been very let down by the producers' attitude to my wanting to move on to other projects, especially as my character was doing so little... They made it very difficult for me, and I just didn't want to know what was happening with my character...

I decided to leave the show as, first, I didn't have a contract, second, my part had no depth of character and there seemed nowhere to go with it!

I loved *Lorimar*'s early days and was sad to see the change though it was certainly better for me as new faces meant that old quarrels could be forgotten!
